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
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Past Perfect Simple Past Perfect Progressive



I had (I'd) worked.
I had not (hadn't) worked.
Had I worked?

I had been working.
I had not been working.
Had I been working?

The Past Perfect Simple is used:

- for a past action that was completed before another past action. We use the Past Perfect Simple for the first action and the Past Simple for the second action:
 - When we arrived at the airport, the plane had already taken off.
- for an action that was completed before a definite time in the past:
- I had finished my homework by 6:00 p.m. yesterday.

The Past Perfect Progressive is used:

- to emphasise the duration of an action that was happening before another one in the past:
 I had been waiting for two hours when he finally came
- for an action which had been going on in the past and its results were visible later on in the past:

The firemen looked exhausted. They had been trying to put out the fire for six hours.

Time Expressions

by + time, by the time, after, before, when etc.

when, for, since, after, before, how long etc.

NOTE

in. When we use **before** or **after** to describe the **first** of two actions that happened in the past, we can use the **Past Simple** instead of the **Past Perfect Simple**:

The students had come before the teacher arrived. OR The students came before the teacher arrived.
