

BUT:

The opposites of many English words are formed by adding a negative prefix to the words. The most common negative prefixes are un-, in-, dis- and mis-.

• Most words that derive from the same root take the same negative prefix as the root word:

approval → disapproval approve → disapprove approving **→** disapproving approvingly -> disapprovingly

· Sometimes verbs, nouns, adjectives or adverbs deriving from the same root form their opposites with the addition of different negative prefixes:

comfort → discomfort (noun) comfortable → uncomfortable (adjective) fortune → misfortune (noun) fortunate → unfortunate (adjective)

informed (adj) **un**informed (=not informed), **misinformed** (=wrongly informed)

equal → unequal (adjective) equality > inequality (noun)

 Some words of the same category (verbs, nouns or adjectives) deriving from one root form two opposites using two different negative prefixes - but with a difference in meaning: able (adj) → unable (=not able), disabled (=handicapped)
